

1. **Slide 1 (Presentation Structure):**

- **Introduction:** Briefly introduce the project background to spark interest.
- **Problem Statement:** Outline the problem background and market pain points.
- **Main Content:** Present the solution, current development status, future prospects, and challenges.
- **Limitations:** Identify any constraints and discuss future research or development directions.
- **Conclusion:** Summarize the main points of the presentation.
- **Total Duration: 2 minutes.**

2. **Slide 2 (Presentation Outline Overview):**

- Provide an overview of the presentation structure.
- Highlight key points of each section.
- Optimize the audience's first impression.
- Help the audience quickly grasp the key points of the presentation.

3. **Slide 3 (Transition Phrases):**

- Use phrases to guide the audience:
  - "Let's start with..."
  - "Next, we would like to discuss..."
  - "As mentioned earlier..."
  - "Now, let's continue..."

4. **Slide 4 (Market Opportunity & Business Model):**

- Explain the target market and its needs, market size.
- Showcase the unique selling points of the business model.
- **Total Duration: 1 minute 30 seconds.**

5. **Slide 5 (Gesture Techniques in Presentations):**

- Explain how to use gestures to emphasize key points in the presentation (e.g., "Use gestures to highlight your market size").
- **Total Duration: 30 seconds.**

6. **Slide 6 (Competitive Advantage & Image Relevance):**

- Emphasize the project's competitive advantages, using charts to compare with market competitors.
- Remind the audience of the relevance between images and content; keep titles concise.

- **Total Duration: 1 minute 30 seconds.**
- 7. **Slide 7 (Expectations & Team Introduction):**
  - Present expectations and future plans, including charts and data.
  - Briefly introduce the core team's background.
  - **Total Duration: 1 minute 30 seconds.**
- 8. **Slide 8 (Structured Persuasive Presentation):**
  - Use the point-reason-example-summary model to deliver a persuasive presentation and look to the future.
  - Avoid reading directly from the slides. (Do not over-rely on the PPT)
  - Interact with the audience rather than just reading the text on the slides.
  - **Total Duration: 1 minute.**

The total presentation duration should be **7-9 minutes**, ensuring that information is clearly conveyed for each section while allowing time for interaction and summarizing.
